**Police investigate armed robbery**

Authorities with the Milledgeville Police Department are seeking information regarding a recent armed robbery that took place at a Thompson Circle location.

Wednesday, March 28 at around 9:24 p.m., a call came in from a Papa John's delivery person regarding an alleged armed robbery that occurred. The victim stated while attempting to make a delivery to a vacant residence in the 200 block of Thompson Circle, he was approached by a young male wearing a gray sweat suit. Upon arrival to the address given for the pizza delivery, the unknown male asked the Papa John's employee if he was the delivery guy. Shortly after, another young man wearing an all black running suit and a black mask appeared from a wooded area nearby. The victim stated the masked suspect approached him, holding a gun, demanding that he give up all his money. The delivery personnel gave the suspect his wallet. After removing an undisclosed amount of money from the wallet, returned the wallet back to the victim then ran back into the wooded area. While the victim proceeded to dial 911, the suspect wearing the gray sweat suit grabbed the 3 pizzas the delivery guy had with him and ran off into the wooded area behind the second suspect.
